GETTING THERE

Jilabun stream and waterfalls are 25 km away from Odem. An easy drive of 25 minutes.

It is also easy getting there by hitchhiking, which is very common and safe around the Golan Heights.

Behind The Rainbow

Jilabun waterfall is a short hike but tricky one. Due to the height difference between the Golan Heights and the Hula Valley, a canyon was created, and the water is carried through waterfalls and pools. The Jilabun stream gets its name from the Syrian village, Jalabina, which was located there. This is a circular route, of medium difficulty due to the steep climb at the end, and takes about 2 hours. You can swim in the pool, the water is deep at the end. You can climb and sit behind the waterfall.
